Travel to Kafue's Busanga Plains on this Zambia Safari, known for its territorial lions roaming alongside other predators and a multitude of plains game while adventures on the Zambezi River yield sightings of elephant, buffalo, crocodile, hippo. Here you can also choose a heli flip over Victoria Falls or hurl yourself into the spectacular Batoka Gorge by bungee jump or gorge swing.

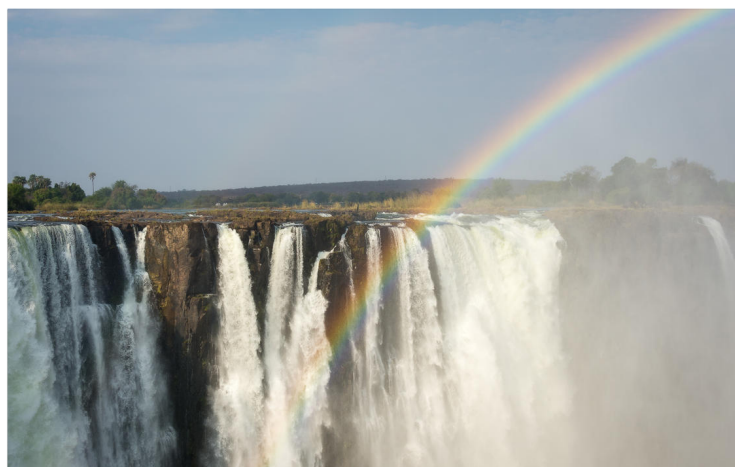

## Camps

**Busanga Bush Camp:** Busanga Bush Camp, an adventure camp, lies on a verdant island in the middle of Kafue's Busanga Plains. See the diverse wildlife in one of the most remote areas on the planet on the day and night drives and seasonal boating, or a hot air balloon ride by air. (Available August to October; conservation fee applies)

This intimate camp has just four tents set under leafy fig trees. The main area – under canvas – is a favorite space amongst guests, particularly at sunrise when the rising mist gradually reveals masses of lechwe and puku dotted across the floodplain. Dining also takes place under the canopy of a majestic tree from which an unusual lantern chandelier hangs, romantically lighting up dinner.

NOTE: Busanga Bush Camp is open between 01 June and 31 October each year.



**Toka Leya Camp:** Overlooking the Zambezi River and some of its islands, Toka Leya, a classic safari style camp is the ideal combination of relaxation and adventure. Game drives and river cruises can be followed by a therapeutic treatment at the spa. Expert-led tour of Victoria Falls, community visits to the nearby rural village, and the Livingstone town, fishing, rhino tracking, and plenty of adrenaline-filled activities add excitement to the experience.

The camp's expansive main area and its rim-flow pool, have gorgeous views of the majestic river and its wildlife. Twelve tasteful safari-style tents, each have an indulgent outdoor bath and a large wooden deck.
